### **Sparkling & Champagne**

GRAHAM BECK BRUT ROSÉ. SOUTH AFRICA. Bottle 30.00.

Pale silvery pink, with aromas of raspberry and cherry, with some subtle mineral hints. Bright acidity and fine mousse balance well with the ripeness of the crushed berry flavours.

NYETIMBER CLASSIC CUVÉE. ENGLAND. Half Bottle 35.00 Bottle 70.00.

A beguilingly Champagne-like nose of citrus fruit, brioche and shortbread. The mousse is finely pearled, soft, yet mouth-filling and persistent. Elegantly shaped and supremely poised.

APERICENA PROSECCO. ITALY. 125ml 7.00 Bottle 23.00.

Delicate and aromatic with fine bubbles. This wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear and an elegant zest.

CHAPEL DOWN SPARKLING BACCHUS. ENGLAND. Bottle 38.00.

Bacchus is the Ancient Greek god of wine. He's lent his name to what is now England's star grape. It's taken Chapel Down, official supplier to 10 Downing Street and the Oxford & Cambridge Boat Races, 18 years to perfect the art. But it's finally arrived. It's a glorious streak of pineapple, grapefruit and elderflower that runs through arrow-precise bubbles.

NICOLAS COURTIN BRUT NV. CHAMPAGNE. Bottle 45.00.

Each and every detail of Nicolas Courtin is attentively observed to ensure that what reaches your flute is pure, elegant Champagne. It's rich and smooth, white notes of toast, citrus and apple and a delicate mousse.

CATTIER PREMIER CRU BRUT . CHAMPAGNE. Bottle 65.00.

it is bright and equally intense, with brioche and peach notes giving way to citrus fruits. These are followed by softer nutty flavours, and notes of acacia honey and forest fruits. The finish is long, with a wonderful freshness that will keep you reaching for your glass.

### Rosé Wine

BEL CANTO PINOT GRIGIO ROSÉ. ITALY. Bottle 22.00.

Pale pink wine, bright, rich in red fruits and floral on the nose, fresh, crunchy taste, with a good structure.

NICOLAS ROUZET, COTEAUX D'AIX EN PROVENCE ROSÉ. SOUTH OF FRANCE. Bottle 32.00.

Rosé with a beautiful colour with lychee hues. On the nose, it is both fine and elegant with red berries notes. The palate attack is round and marked by red berries aromas (strawberries, raspberry, redcurrant) with at the ending a fresh notes.

#### White Wine

DOMINIO DE LA FUENTE VERDEJO, ORGANIC. SPAIN.

125ml 5.20. 175ml 6.90. 250ml 8.30. Bottle 23.00.

A crisp, aromatic white wine, showing great purity of aromas. Bright, pale straw yellow, with intense, fresh notes of grass, fennel and white pepper.

LYRARAKIS ASSYRTIK. GREECE. Bottle 30.00.

This is balanced and crisp, with flavours of green apple, citrus and stone fruits. Pair this with rosemary chicken.

CASAL DE VENTOZELA ALVARINHO. PORTUGAL. Bottle 31.00.

This lively yellow wine is extremely fresh with flavours of citrus and apple. Complexity and depth are added by ageing in oak barrels and time spent on its lees.

LANGUORE TREBBIANO CHARDONNAY RUBICONE. ITALY.

125ml 4.50. 175ml 6.00. 250ml 7.20. Bottle 20.00.

Straw-yellow with light greenish hue. Intense, with tropical fruit and flowers.

Structured and full bodied, smooth, and well balanced.

#### White Wine

THE PARODIST PINOT GRIGIO. HUNGARY.

125ml 5.65. 175ml 7.55. 250ml 9.00. Bottle 25.00.

This Pinot Grigio offers a delightfully pure, fragrant expression of this highly popular grape variety and has abundant peach and grapefruit flavours, accompanied by a ripe citrus fragrance.

### RISCOS VIOGNIER. CHILE.

125ml 5.40. 175ml 7.20. 250ml 8.60. Bottle 24.00.

Nose of medium-high intensity, with notes of fresh white fruit and soft floral aromas. On the palate are fruity notes, with silkiness and freshness.

### FINGER POST SAUVIGNON BLANC. NEW ZEALAND.

125ml 7.20. 175ml 9.65. 250ml 11.50. Bottle 32.00.

An elegant Sauvignon Blanc with aromas of gooseberries and tropical fruit leading to a crisp and refreshing finish.

#### ZACCAGNINI VERDICCIO DOCG. ITALY. Bottle 27.00.

Verdicchio is the most widely planted white grape variety in Marche, making it integral to the history of the land. It's crisp and dry with notes of citrus and a fresh saline aroma. Enjoy it with fine cuts of Prosscuitto.

WINZER KREMS ORANGE GRÜNER VELTLINER. AUSTRIA. Bottle 28.00. This Grüner Veltliner "ORANGE" is made from white Grüner Veltliner grapes, left to ferment on the grape skins for 18 days to develop a deeper colour and a rich textural, spicy complexity.

### TEIXADAL TREIXADURA. SPAIN. Bottle 29.00.

Refreshing Treixadura grapes lend plenty of nectarine and citrus fruit aromas and - because the wine has been rested on its lees for a while before bottling satisfying complexity too.



#### White Wine

KING STAG CHARDONNAY. CALIFORNIA. Bottle 34.00.

Complex aromas of white peach, orange blossom, and a touch of vanilla. The creamy mouthfeel is balanced by a crisp acidity and a refreshing finish.

CHAPEL DOWN BACCHUS. ENGLAND. Bottle 42.00.

The warm summer of 2013 shines through giving intense aromas of grapefruit, gooseberries and freshly cut grass. Fresh with green apple and nettles flavours leaving a clean, crisp finish.

#### **Red Wine**

WILD OCEAN CABERNET-MERLOT. SOUTH AFRICA.

125ml 5.85. 175ml 7.85. 250ml 9.35. Bottle 26.00.


A richly-textured velvety wine with ripe plum and blackcurrant fruit aromas and a touch of vanilla oak. Soft and juicy.

MOZZAFIATO PRIMITIVO. ITALY. Bottle 27.00.

This Primitivo has a mouth-coating palate of dried prune, date and cherry, with notes of sweet spice and a lick of chocolate. Great structure from the good balance between the soft tannins and acidity.

DOMAINE DES TOURELLES CUVEE PIERRE BRUN. LEBANON. Bottle 35.00. Founded in 1868, Tourelles is Lebanon's oldest winery. A blend of Cabernet, Syrah, Cinsault and Carignan, this has fine aromatic morello cherry and spice aromas, a dark fruit core with layered earthy spice, and balanced tannins.

#### **Red Wine**

FIVE RAVENS PINOT NOIR. ROMANIA. Bottle 22.00.

Romania may not be the first place you think of when you are looking to buy a Pinot Noir but this has all the classic bright red fruit flavours and spicy note you would expect.

UNDER THE SYCAMORE SHIRAZ. AUSTRALIA.

125ml 5.20. 175ml 6.90. 250ml 8.30. Bottle 23.00.

Silky smooth with lashings of blackcurrant, bramble and white pepper.

MERLOT RESERVA, TERRA VEGA. CHILE.

125ml 5.20. 175ml 6.90. 250ml 8.30. Bottle 23.00.

The wine delivers a solid core of concentrated fruit, hinting at blackberry preserves and damson plums.

QUID PRO QUO MALBEC. ARGENTINA.

125ml 7.20. 175ml 9.65. 250ml 11.50. Bottle 32.00.

Elegantly structured, rich, showing plummy fruit and hints of smoke and chocolate.

LANGUORE SANGIOVESE. ITALY. Bottle 20.00.

Intense red ruby colour, with violet hue. Its aromatic profile combines ripe cherry and blackberry. Well balanced, fresh and medium bodied to the palate.

TARIMA MONASTRELL, ALICANTE. SPAIN. Bottle 25.50.

The powerful fruit flavours of brambles and dark cherries are lifted by an elegant floral finish in this soft and rounded wine.

WISDOM TREE DAO. PORTUGAL. Bottle 28.00.

Delightfully soft and rounded, this wine is full of plum and bramble flavours with touches of herbs and a slight spiciness to finish.



### **Red Wine**

BERONIA CZA CRIANZA LIMITADA. SPAIN. Bottle 37.00.

Attractive and intriguing on the nose, prominent aromas of red cherry fruit overlay a backdrop of cinnamon, cacao and spicy pepper notes. Hints of camomile and thyme bring an element of freshness. This wine is ripe and juicy on the palate. Velvety tannins balance perfectly with the chocolate and dark fruit characteristics, resulting in a long, silky, finish.

ELLA'S RIDGE PINOT NOIR. NEW ZEALAND. 39.00.

Bright and fresh with varietal ripe cherry aromas, with vibrant flavours of red berries and spice. A fresh and lively palate, with silky tannins and a lingering finish.
